DFW is home to nearly 7 million people, and Dallas ranks as the fourth most diverse city in the United States (WalletHub, 2021). Dallas is also home to the nation's sixth largest LGBTQ+ community.



Here, modern luxury coexists with down-to-earth American rodeo and ranch culture, and the area is also home to some of the top names in American sports – Dallas Cowboys, Mavericks, Stars, FC Dallas and the new home to PGA Golf.

Visitors to DFW have 9,286 square miles of options. You'll find lodging to suit any taste or preference and diverse dining experiences from "down-home southern cookin", Texas barbeque and Tex-Mex, to international and five-



star dining experiences. If you're looking for entertainment and nightlife in Dallas, check out the urban wine trails and the margarita mile, catch a drag or burlesque show, and don't miss the Dallas neighborhoods of Oak Lawn (the epicenter of "gay Dallas"), Deep Ellum, the Design District, Uptown, and the Dallas Arts District.

For those seeking culture, DFW offers one of the world's top opera houses (Bass Performance Hall), art galleries such as the Kimball Museum and the Nasher Sculpture

Center, and museums including the Sixth Floor Museum at Dealey Plaza (the location where John F. Kennedy was shot), the Dallas Holocaust and **Human Rights** Museum, and the Perot Museum of Nature and Science.





DFW is also home to many LGBTQ+ affirming congregations such as the Congregation Beth El Binah, The Dallas Buddhist Center, Radha Kalachandji Hare Krishna Temple, Kadampa Meditation Center, and the Cathedral of Hope, the world's largest inclusive liberal Christian church primarily serving the LGBTQ+ community.

For an authentically Texas experience head over to the Fort Worth side of the metroplex and check out the world's only twice-daily, long-horn cattle drive which goes right down the middle of the brick-paved street! Or visit the Stockyards Championship Rodeo for live bull riding, barrel racing, calf roping and a wild west show. At night, you may want to check out world-famous Billy Bob's, a massive, three-acre country music venue known as "the world's largest honky-tonk". If you're interested in cowboy history, visit the National Cowgirl Museum, or the National Cowboys of Color Museum.



If shopping is your thing, Dallas is home to fantastic high-end shopping including the Nieman Marcus flagship store, the Galleria Mall and the Shops at Highland Park. Sundance Square, in Fort Worth, is a 20-block neighborhood of brickpaved sidewalks and historical buildings with some of the most unique shopping ever.

While in DFW, you may want to take a short drive to Waco, Texas to visit the Magnolia Market at the Silos (made famous by television's Chip and Joana Gaines), and the world's largest flea market "First Monday Trade Days" in Canton, Texas.

Of course, there are also many great seasonal events such as the Texas State Fair, the Gay Rodeo, Scarborough Renaissance Festival, Dallas Pride and so much more!


It takes about three years for SART to gather, finalize and verify data. So, the most current, verified numbers will be from about three years ago.


Here are some of the most important things you should know and consider:

- 1. Look for SART-Verified Data: If you look at SART rates, you may notice that the date on them makes them appear to be "old". That's because it takes about three years for SART to gather, finalize and verify the data. So, the most current, verified numbers will actually be from about three years ago. Clinics that report to SART subject their data to very strict reporting standards. It limits what we can say, and how we can say it, but the value to you is that you know our data is third-party verified. Be wary of data that is not verified by SART.
- **2. Make Sure the Data is "Honest":** FST prides itself on honest reporting practices. While some clinics may try to skew their data by only accepting patients with the best chances for "success", or only those patients who

will go along with the treatment method the clinic prefers, FST is committed to walking alongside our patients, and helping them in the way that honors their personal preferences, beliefs and wishes. This isn't always the fastest way to grow our success rates, but we have the expertise to overcome difficult odds, and we're willing to do what's best for our patients, medically, emotionally and financially.

- **3. Compare Based on What Applies to You:** When comparing clinic data, look at your age group/donor egg, genetic testing of embryos and fresh versus frozen transfers, etc.
- **4. Look for IVF Expertise and Experience:** At FST, our physicians regularly perform more than 1,500 cycles per year. We understand the nuances of the procedure and we know how to achieve results.






